

## Ultrasound Exam Emergent/Urgent Add-On Requests For Community Providers

## Process:

- The provider's office contacts ultrasound directly at (513) 636-3177 (follow the prompts for same-day appointment requests).
- Ultrasound staff work with provider's office to identify a time/location for the patient to be seen (see table below).
- Do not fax the order to our referral team; we will provide the fax number based on which location the patient will be seen.
- The provider's office contacts the patient/family with the appointment details and prep instructions.
- Please note:
  - If we do not have an appointment time available, we may instead ask that the patient arrive as soon as possible to be worked in.
  - Same-day add-on appointments may be limited or unavailable in the evenings or on weekends depending on outpatient registration availability and volume of pending emergent requests.

Same Day (Emergent)	ASAP (Urgent)
Scrotal w/Doppler  Concern for Testicular Torsion or Rupture	Abdomen  • Acute symptoms of Cholecystitis or Biliary Disease
Pelvis (TABD or TV) w/Doppler  Concern for Ovarian Torsion	Pelvis (TABD or TV)  • Concern for PID/TOA
RLQ/Appendix	Abscess • Head/neck, Buttocks, etc.
Incarcerated Hernia (Scrotal/Inguinal/Abdominal)	DVT
Intussusception	Pylorus (through 6 months of age)
Hip Effusion	Renal  Acute symptoms of Nephrolithiasis (stones)/Obstruction
<ul> <li>Limited Abdomen</li> <li>Concern for intrabdominal mass (palpable on clinical exam)</li> </ul>	

Exams listed above as ASAP (Urgent) may be added on the same day or be deferred to the next available appointment depending on patient acuity.
