

## Inpatient Rehabilitation Cancer Specialty Program

The Pediatric Cancer Rehabilitation Specialty Program at Cincinnati Children's is a component of the Inpatient Pediatric Rehabilitation Program's 12 bed unit that provides acute rehabilitation services for children, adolescents and young adults. The Cancer Rehabilitation Specialty Program is available to patients at any level of care required as a cancer patient.

Our Cancer Specialty program is the first in the world to have a CARF pediatric cancer accreditation.
