

## Mental Health Music Therapy Internship Cincinnati Children's Hospital, College Hill Campus

This internship is based out of our mental health campus in the College Hill neighborhood of Cincinnati. Our College Hill campus contains over 100 beds, all of which are dedicated to providing mental health services to youth.



Music therapy interns have learning opportunities in the following areas:

- Inpatient (*short-term acute care for youth experiencing a mental health crisis*)
  - Child Program (~ ages 5-12)
  - Adolescent Program (~ ages 13-17)
  - Neurobehavioral Program (*children and teens who have both mental health needs and a developmental/neurological disability*)
- Residential (*long-term care for youth with chronic mental health needs*)
  - Child Program (~ ages 8-12)
  - Adolescent Programs (~ ages 13-17)

### Internship Experiences

Interns begin by observing all 3 of the music therapists at College Hill. They then transition into co-leading with their supervisors. When interns show readiness, they begin leading sessions independently. Once interns are ready to maintain their own caseload, about half of their sessions are groups and about half are individual sessions. Interns chart responses from all groups and individual sessions in the hospital's electronic medical record.

Other clinical and professional development experiences for interns include:

- Three special projects, all of which are designed to directly compliment interns' clinical work
- Weekly time dedicated to refining clinical musicianship
- Weekly supervision with internship director
- Frequent opportunities for in-the-moment supervision and feedback with all supervisors
- Peer supervision with multi-disciplinary students/interns
- Opportunities for co-treating groups and individual sessions with other disciplines
- Participation in treatment team rounds and care conferences
- Participation in music therapy team meetings and division staff meetings
- Observations with music therapists in our hospital's medical and hospice/palliative care programs
